Do not live among people and do not rely on them for their welfare needs.

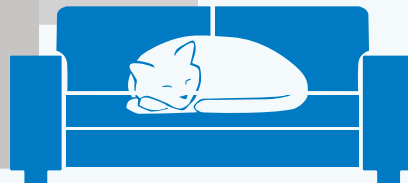
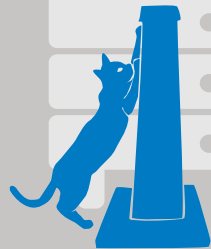


LIVES WITH PEOPLE

STRAY CATS
